Annual gender sensitization action plan

The institution is always very keen regarding safety and security of the female students and faculty members and is always concerned with their betterment socially, politically, and economically.

Specific facilities provided for women in terms of:

a) Safety and security:

The safety and security of all the students, teachers, non-teaching staff and the visitors to the college are always the first priority. To ensure a secured environment the college has adopted the following practices:

- Anti Ragging Committee: The college has an Anti Ragging Committee in place. The anti ragging
 helpline details are provided on the college website. On the first day of the Orientation Programme the
 students are informed about the committee and are also introduced to the members of the Committee for
 any assistance.
- Internal Complaints Committee: The Internal Complaints Committee is constituted as per guidelines of
 the UGC for prohibition of Sexual Harassment. The students are given a brief introduction on ICC during
 orientation programmes and a seminar on the same is organized for the students.
- Zero Tolerance Policy: There are posters at prime locations to emphasize on the Zero Tolerance Policy of the college on issues related to sexual harassment.
 - Online form for Grievance Redressal is there for the students. Students can complain secretly and safely without any hesitation and everything is kept confidential.
- **Cyber Security:** The link of the national Cyber Security reporting Portal is is provided on the college website for helping the stakeholders to report on any cases of cyber crime.
